- Leading and coordinating activities and recommending policies that promote economy, efficiency, and effectiveness in SSA programs and operations, as well as that prevent and detect fraud and abuse in such programs and operations; and
- Keeping the Commissioner of Social Security and Congress fully and currently informed about fraud, waste, abuses, and deficiencies in programs and operations, as well as progress in implementing corrective actions.

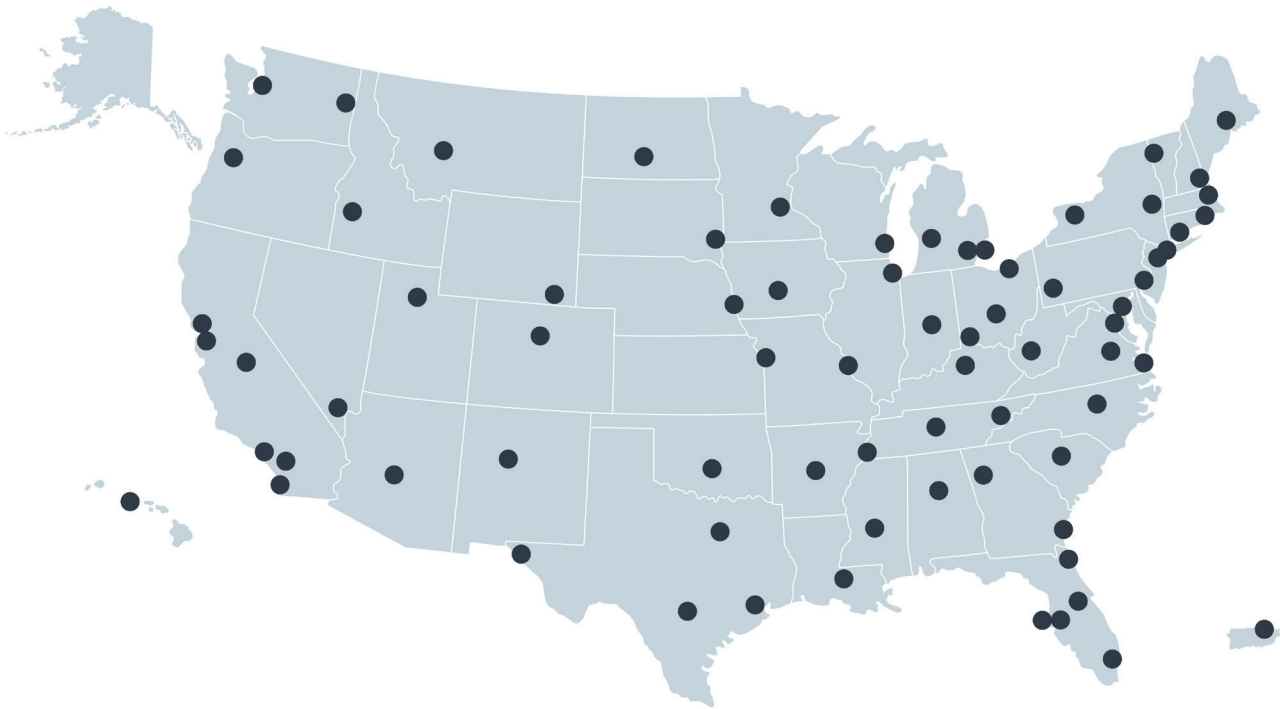
A Great Place to Work
